Computers, Servers, and Printing My workstation's hard drive is full. How can I free up space on it?

There are several methods to free up hard disk space:

- 1. Empty the recycle bin.
 - Right click on the recycling bin on the desktop and press Empty Recycle Bin.
- 2. Perform a disk cleanup:
 - Press the Windows key or click on the start menu.
 - Start typing **disk cleanup** and press enter.
 - Select the files you wish to delete.
- 3. Change how much mail to keep offline (Outlook, Windows 10).

Click File > Account Settings > Account Settings.

- Select your Exchange or Office 365 account, and then click **Change**.
- Under Offline Settings, move the slider to 3 months. Note this will not delete the exisiting emails, only prevent copies from being held past 3 months.
- Close and restart Outlook.
